	Please read and initial the guidelines, then sign and date at the bottom.
1.	When spending time with the animals, volunteers must spend a minimum of 30 minutes with each animal to ensure that they get a reasonable break from their kennel.
2.	Only animals 6 months and older are available for play time. This helps keep everyone healthy as the animals have not completed their vaccinations until 6 months of age.
3.	When walking a dog, volunteers must be wearing closed-toed and closed-heel shoes . This prevents volunteers from tripping or slipping out of their shoes and injuring themselves or releasing the dog.
4.	To volunteer alone, you must be 16 years or older . If under age, volunteers must be accompanied by an adult/guardian 19 years of age or older.
5.	A volunteer MUST be 16 years or older to hold the leash of ANY dog. This is to prevent a dog from pulling too strongly resulting in a fall of the volunteer or release of the leash.
6.	When socializing with an animal, volunteers must NOT let the animal near other animals. Some of our animals are not always friendly with other animals and in order to maintain the safety of everyone involved we ask that no animals come within 10 feet of each other. (If volunteering with a friend, you can either spend time with one animal at a time together, OR each interact with a different animal separately. At no time should the animals meet.)
7.	Volunteers should always present themselves in a respectful and responsible manner. Volunteers are an important part of CNHS and can be a great support system to the staff. By being disrespectful or irresponsible, volunteers disrupt the staff from efficiently preforming their jobs. This creates a disservice to our animals.
8.	Throughout the shelter there are areas designated for staff only. These areas are strictly off limits to all volunteers. In certain situations, volunteers may be permitted to these areas, this is a temporary permission that must be granted by staff. Volunteers in these areas must be accompanied by staff.
9.	While the staff enjoys the company of volunteers, they have job responsibilities that need to be met. Volunteers need to limit the time spent socializing and being at the counter without a task. If volunteering for community service, volunteers must be actively working at all times. Once a task is completed another one should be requested.
10.	No volunteer should be behind the front counter unless asked by staff. Please respect the staff's work area at all times.
